









Impact of eTwinning in Europe



~ 320 000 schools in Europe 144 000 eTwinning schools 45% of European schools



6 000 000 teachers
324 000 eTwinning teachers
5.4% of European teachers
(Around 2 eTwinning teachers per school)



Different phases of eTwinning








MONITORING SURVEY 2014/15






Response rate by country








Positive impact of eTwinning on teachers' skills
